

## Old-series banknotes

If you travel to New Caledonia in French Polynesia or to Wallis and Futuna between 20 January 2014 and 30 September 2014, you may still receive banknotes from the old series (shown below).



## Important information for foreign travellers

From  
20 January  
2014

After this date, all bureaux de change, cash dispensers and retailers will distribute the new banknotes shown in this document.

From  
20 January to  
30 September  
2014

You may still receive banknotes from the old series, and they can be used for all payments or purchases.

From 30  
September  
2014

You should not accept banknotes from the old series. Make sure you have used up all old-series banknotes in your possession by this date.

# MAIN SECURITY FEATURES

## 1 • See-through motif

marks printed on both sides of the banknote combine perfectly to form a motif. The complete motif can be seen when the banknote is held against the light.



## 2 • Raised print

feels thicker to the touch



## 3 • Silvery stripe

the value of the banknote can be seen and the letters CFP change from gold to grey when the note is tilted

4 • Embossed letters  
the letters CFP can be seen in oblique light



7 • Two identical serial numbers  
one of which is in the dominant colour of the banknote

6 • Watermark  
visible when the banknote is held against the light



5 • Security thread  
the initials IEOM can be seen written in tiny letters when the banknote is held against the light



## 1 • See-through motif

marks printed on both sides of the banknote combine perfectly to form a motif. The complete motif can be seen when the banknote is held against the light



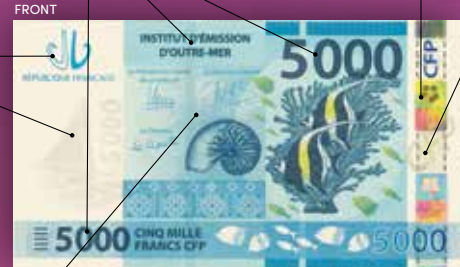
## 2 • Raised print

feels thicker to the touch



3 • Partially demetallized hologram stripe  
the image changes and a rainbow-like effect can be seen when the banknote is tilted.

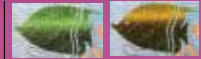
4 • Embossed letters  
the letters CFP can be seen in oblique light



6 • Watermark  
visible when the banknote is held against the light



8 • Dynamic colour-changing pattern  
the colour gradually changes from yellow to green when the banknote is tilted



5 • Security thread  
the IEOM logo and words INSTITUT D'ÉMISSION D'OUTRE-MER can be seen when the banknote is held against the light



9 • Metallic windowed security thread  
the colour changes from green to blue when the banknote is tilted



7 • Two identical serial numbers  
one of which is in the dominant colour of the banknote
